SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. These **Special Conditions of Play** need to be read in conjunction with Bowls Auckland Centre Events General Conditions of Play.

2. Dates, venues and times

Tournament	Dates	Reserve dates
1-5 Year Men's & Women's Triples	16–17 September 2023	28–29 October 2023
1-5 Year Men's & Women's Pairs	14–15 October 2023	28–29 October 2023
1-5 Year Fours	27–28 April 2024	22 June 2024
1-5 Year Men's & Women's Singles	8–9 June 2024	22 June 2024

b) Venues: Qualifying and Post Section venues will be advised when the draw is released.

c) Start time: All games will start by 9:00am for each day.

3. Entry

Participants must be full-playing members of a Bowls Auckland affiliated club and must be in their first five years of membership.

4. Teams

Teams in the Fours can be any combinations.

5. Playing format

Singles Four (4) rounds, with one round a marking requirement.

21 shots or 2 hours whichever occurs first.

Four (4) bowls each.

Post section games will be 21/4 hours.

Pairs Up to three (3) rounds per day.

18 ends or 21/4 hours, whichever occurs first

Three (3) bowls each.

Triples Up to three (3) rounds per day.

18 ends or 2¼ hours, whichever occurs first.

Two (2) bowls each.

Fours Up to three (3) rounds per day.

15 ends or 2¼ hours, whichever occurs first.

Two (2) bowls each.

6. Marking Singles

- a) Qualifying: Every player in the qualifying rounds with a M by their name is required to mark.
- b) **Post Section:** All qualifiers must bring their own marker for their first round of Post Section play. A non-winning Player must be available to mark the next match.
- c) **Failure to mark**: In both Qualifying and Post Section, any player who fails to fulfil their marking duties may be subject to a fine of \$50. Players are not to leave the venue before checking with the Umpire
- **7. Restricting the movement of players during play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head as follows:

Singles After delivery of their third and fourth bowls.

In exceptional and limited circumstances, a player can ask the marker for permission to walk up to the head earlier than described above. If a player does not meet the terms of this

condition, Law 13 will apply.

Pairs Leads: after delivery of their third bowl

Skips: after delivery of their second and third bowl

Triples Leads: after the Seconds have delivered their second bowl

Seconds: after delivery of their second bowl Skips: after delivery of each of their bowls

Fours Leads: after the Thirds have delivered their second bowl

Seconds: after the Thirds have delivered their second bowl

Thirds: after delivery of their second bowl Skips: after delivery of each of their bowls

In exceptional and limited circumstances, a Skip can ask that a player walks up to the head earlier than described above. If a player does not meet the terms of this condition, Law 13 will apply.

8. Prize money: Prize money will be direct credited into a nominated bank account.

Winner: \$200 per person per event` Runners-up: \$100 per person per event
