#### 1. Event Disciplines & Dates

### 2. Entry Conditions

- a) All participants must be full-playing members of the same Bowls Auckland affiliated club.
- b) \*1–5-Year Events All participants must have five years or less of playing experience.
  - \*\*1-5 Year Fours is any combination.
- c) All entries are received via Bowlshub only, all entries must be linked to player profiles.
  - o Entries via phone, text or email will not be accepted.

#### 3. Draw & Venues

- a) Draw/s will be published, with venues on Bowlshub.
- b) Hosting venues will be listed on the events page of the Bowls Auckland website.

## 6. Marking

- c) During singles events, players are required to mark.

  - o In some cases, this may include marking more than once per day, although efforts will be made to avoid this where possible.
  - o Marking requirements will be published on the draw where possible.
- d) During singles events, players are not to leave the venue until they have been cleared by the umpire to do so.
