Centre Events (1-5 Women's Triples – Special Conditions)

The following Event Conditions of Play are to be read in conjunction with the Bowls Auckland General Conditions of Play.

1. Dates and Entry Conditions

- a) Qualifying 9th May, Post-Section 10th May
- b) All participants must be full-playing members of the same Bowls Auckland-affiliated club.
- c) *1–5-Year Events - All participants must have five years or less of playing experience.
- d) All entries to be received via Bowlshub only, and all entries must be linked to player profiles.
 - o Entries via phone, text or email will not be accepted.

2. Draw & Venues

- a) Draw/s will be published, with venues on Bowlshub.
- b) Hosting venues will be listed on the events page of the Bowls Auckland website.

4. Playing Format

Triples	Two (2) bowls each, 18 ends.
Time Limit/s	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All games will have a time limit of two hours. • The Final will have no time limit.
Games Played	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Up to four rounds will be played each day.
Qualification	1-5 Triples Special Conditions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Due to low entry numbers, all teams will be drawn into a single section playing four rounds • Teams will play to earn the highest Match Points and Net total of shots • The top four-ranked teams after four rounds will advance to the semi-final on Sunday to a predetermined bracket. • 1v4, 2v3
Dead Ends “RE-SPOT” Law 19.5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In the event an end is made dead (Law 19), the jack must be placed with the nearest point of the jack to the mat line at the appropriate re-spot position described in Law 56.5.3, (the 2-metre mark) or as close as possible as described in Law 56.5.4, and play must continue.
