1. These Special Conditions of Play need to be read in conjunction with Bowls Auckland Centre Events General Conditions of Play.
2. Schedule dates:

3. Venues: Qualifying and Post-section venues will be advised when the draw is released
4. Play:
a) All games will commence by 9:00am.
b) Qualifying: For team games three rounds per day will be scheduled. The Singles will consist of four rounds with one round being a marking requirement.
c) Post Section: Four rounds per day will be scheduled.
5. Marking in Singles tournament:
a) Qualifying: Every player in the qualifying rounds with a M by their name is required to mark.
b) Post Section: All qualifiers must bring their own marker for their first round of Post Section play. A losing singles player must be available to mark the next match.
c) Failure to mark: In both Qualifying and Post Section, any player who fails to fulfil their marking duties may be subject to be a fine of $\$ 50$. Players are not to leave the venue before checking with the Umpire.
6. Format:

Singles Four (4) bowls each. Games will be 21 shots or time, whichever occurs first. Qualifying games will be two (2) hours. Post section games will be $21 / 4$ hours.
Pairs Three (3) bowls each. Games will be 18 ends or $21 / 4$ hours, whichever occurs first.
Triples Two (2) bowls each. Games will be 18 ends or $21 / 4$ hours, whichever occurs first
Fours Two (2) bowls each. Games will be 15 ends or $2 \frac{1}{4}$ hours, whichever occurs first.
7. Restricting the movement of players during play: In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head as follows:
Singles After delivery of their third and fourth bowls. In exceptional and limited circumstances, a player can ask the marker for permission to walk up to the head earlier than described above. If a player does not meet the terms of this condition, Law 13 will apply.

Pairs Leads: after delivery of their third bowl
Skips: after delivery of their second and third bowl

## AUCKLAND CENTRE EVENTS

## Open Centre Events

Triples Leads: after the Seconds have delivered their second bowl
Seconds: after delivery of their second bowl, both Skips must be at the same end when the first Skip delivers their bowl
Skips: after delivery of each of their bowls
-Fours Leads: after the Thirds have delivered their second bowl
Seconds: after the Thirds have delivered their second bowl
Thirds: after delivery of their second bowl
Skips: after delivery of each of their bowls
In exceptional and limited circumstances, a Skip can ask that a player walks up to the head earlier than described above. If a player does not meet the terms of this condition, Law 13 will apply.
8. Prize money: Prize money will be direct credited into a nominated bank account. Prize money will be based on:
