Necessary Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Hold a current BNZ Development Coach Qualification or higher.
- Be a Full member of and actively coach at the club level.
- Be involved in the winter coaching program.
- Have at least three years of coaching experience.

Application Process

Applicants must submit a cover letter outlining their current coaching activity, suitability for the role, motivation to apply, and expected contributions to the programme.

A **club endorsement** is required, preferably signed by the **Club President or an executive representative**, confirming support for the applicant to serve on a **Bowls Auckland Committee**.
