Venue: Epsom Bowling Club

Dates: Saturday 9th & Sunday 10th August 2025

General Conditions

- 1. The event will be played under the *Laws of the Sport of Bowls* and *Bowls New Zealand Domestic Regulations*.
- 2. The Controlling Body is the Bowls Auckland Coaches Committee, which reserves the right to amend conditions of play to ensure tournament completion.
- 3. All players must comply with the **Bowls Auckland Code of Conduct**, as outlined in the Centre Handbook.
- 4. The tournament is played over **two days**, with **four games on Saturday** and **three** games on Sunday.
 - o Teams will consist of three players, each delivering two bowls.
- 5. No postponements will be made, regardless of weather.
- 6. Due to winter conditions, **mufti clothing** is acceptable. Players are encouraged to wear warm clothing.
- 7. **Cell phone use is not allowed** on or around the greens during play. Phones should be switched off or set to silent.
- 8. **Smoking, vaping, and e-cigarette use is prohibited** on greens and surrounds. Only club-designated smoking areas may be used.
- 9. Players must bring their **own lunch and liquid refreshments**. Any club-provided catering is at the discretion of the host.
- 10.**Trial ends** (one in each direction) may be played before the first game of each day and must be completed **5 minutes before the start time**.
- 11. Any team not ready to play within 15 minutes of the scheduled start will forfeit the game.
- 12. Scorecards must be fully completed for each game, including all player names, game finish time, and both skips' signatures.

















Bowls Auckland 2025-2026 Event Conditions of Play Special Conditions of Play

- 1. Play begins at 9:00 AM on both days.
- 2. Eligibility:
 - Teams must not exceed 10 years of combined playing experience, defined as:
 - JO = New player
 - J1 = One year
 - J2 = Two years
 - J3 = Three years
 - J4 = Four years
 - J5 = Five years

There will be **no exemptions** for this tournament

- 3. Visiting the head is not permitted at any time, including after the final bell.
- 4. In the event of bad weather, play will stop on the bell and bowls and mat must be removed from the green.
 - If all bowls have been played in an end, the score must be agreed upon before play stops.
 - The organising committee may alter the time limit dependent on inclement weather.

5. Game Format:

- Four games on Saturday, three games on Sunday.
- Each game is 1 hour 20 minutes, finishing on the bell.
- Any end started before the bell must be completed.
- 6. In the event of a killed end the jack will be placed on the 2-metre mark and the end continues.
- 7. If the jack is incorrectly delivered, the opposing skip places it on the centre line and may direct mat placement. Normal play resumes.
- 8. Drawn games will be recorded as such.
- 9. Scoring System:
 - Win = 3 points
 - Draw = 1 point
 - Loss = 0 points
