General Conditions

- 1. The event will be played under the Laws of the Sport of Bowls and Bowls New Zealand Domestic Regulations.
- 2. The Controlling Body is the Bowls Auckland Coaches Committee, who reserve the right to alter, add to, or delete any conditions of play and/or special conditions to enable tournament completion.
- 3. All players must observe the Bowls Auckland Code of Conduct, as outlined in the Centre Handbook.
- 4. Teams will be randomly drawn.
- 5. Due to likely cold weather, mufti clothing is allowed. Players are advised to dress warmly.
- 6. Cell phone use is not permitted on or alongside the greens during play. Phones should be switched off or set to silent.
- 7. Smoking, including vaping and e-cigarettes, is prohibited on greens and surrounding areas. Designated smoking areas must be used.
- 8. Players must bring their own lunch and liquid refreshments. Any catering is at the discretion of the host club.
- 9. One trial end may be played in each direction before the first game. These must be completed 5 minutes prior to start time.
- 10. A 15-minute default rule applies: any player not ready to start within 15 minutes of the scheduled time will forfeit the game.
- 11. Scorecards must be completed in full: all player names, time finished, and signatures of both skips are required.

















Bowls Auckland 2025-2026 Event Conditions of Play Special Conditions of Play

1. Start time: 9.00 AM sharp.

2. Eligibility:

- Teams must not exceed 13 years of combined playing experience, based on the following scale:
 - JO = New Player
 - J1 = One year
 - J2 = Two years
 - J3 = Three years
 - J4 = Four years
 - J5 = Five years
- o There will be no exemptions for this tournament

3. Team Composition:

- Four players per team, must be a mixed gender combination.
- Each player delivers 2 bowls.

4. Format:

- Four games, each of 1 hour 20 minutes duration.
- o Games finish on the bell. Any end started before the bell must be completed.
- 5. No visiting the head is permitted at any stage, including after the bell.
- 6. If the jack is incorrectly delivered, the opposing skip will place it on the centre line and direct mat placement. Normal play then resumes.
- 7. If the jack goes out of bounds, it is placed on the 2-metre mark, and the end continues (not a dead end).
- 8. In case of inclement weather:
 - Play stops on the bell.
 - Bowls and mat are removed from the green.

















Bowls Auckland 2025-2026 Event Conditions of Play

- o If all bowls are played in an end, the shots must be agreed upon before leaving the green.
- The organising committee may alter the time limit due to inclement weather
- 9. **Drawn games** are recorded as such.

10. Scoring System:

- Win = 3 points
- Draw = 1 point
- Loss = 0 points
- Rankings are determined in the following order:
 - 1. Total game points
 - 2. Number of ends won
 - 3. Net total shots
 - 4. Lowest shots conceded
